

# Employer Reimbursement Program On-the-Job Training



## What is On-the-Job Training (OJT)?

**OJT** agreements are short-term agreements between an employer and Michigan Works! to provide on-the-job training for newly hired employees, working 30 or more hours per week or more, for a specified training period

**OJT** allows for paid training in a workplace to job ready candidates, designed to enable workers to gain occupational skills that would result in full-time employment. Michigan Works! will reimburse 50% of the employee's wages for a period not to exceed 6 months.
