The plan and goal of Detroit Greenways is to build 70 miles of trails to connect all the neighborhoods in Detroit so people can get from place to place by walking and biking instead of driving. It was suggested that the committee take a trip to learn about the Greening of Detroit, which is an organization that is helping to building greenways.
