Recently, EEI has expressed interest in acquiring city property to develop a renewable energy power plant within the city. Currently, in the Northwest Region of the country, the company has plans underway to develop two 20MW solar power plants in 2012 that will increase the use of solar energy in those areas, as well as create construction and renewable energy jobs.

The Green Enterprise Fund is designed to provide funding for start-up and established businesses that are looking to build an environmentally sustainable business in; Detroit, Hamtramck, Highland Park, Ecorse, River Rouge, Pontiac, and Lincoln Park. Loans up to \$10,000 for Start-ups and up to \$35,000 for established firms (2+ years) are available.
